

Promulgation of Construction Regulations 2014

On Friday 31 January 2014 The Department of Labour announced that the amended Construction Regulations will be promulgated on 10 February 2014. In a notice sent to stakeholders by Phumi Maphaha, the Department's Deputy Director Construction Health and Safety, he said that the promulgation will take place at a special launch event to be held at the Birchwood Hotel, Boksburg, Gauteng. He further said that invitations to attend the event will be sent to stakeholders by the SACPCMP. Saiosh is a registered voluntary association (VA) with SACPCMP and received an invitation and will attend the promulgation/launch and report back to its members.

Promulgation / Launch Programme :

According to the Department of Labour the programme for the event will include an address by the Minister of Labour and the Minister of Public Works. Organised Business (MBSA, SAFCEC and BBCBE) as well as Organised Labour (FEDUSA, NACTU and COSATU) will also be addressing attendees at the launch. The Department of Labour will also be signing a MOU with the SACPCMP who will then be the "recognised body" to register Construction Health and Safety persons as defined in the new Construction Regulations.

The promulgation/launch of the new Construction Regulations is organised by the National Department of Labour in partnership with the National Department of Public Works and the South African Council for the Project and Construction Management Professions (SACPCMP).
